Community is at the heart of Trinity, we provide a rare community led resource for the people of Bristol. Everyone has a story about Trinity, like Davontay, who is one of our two paid interns working on our building heritage project.

These internships were created to provide professional training, skills and opportunity to two young people in Bristol who may otherwise have not had access to work or training, and they are working on our building repair works.

We are seeking help from our community to raise money to restore our building. In 2017, scaffolding was erected to undertake the final phase of major works to repair the fabric of the Grade 2** Listed building. During these works unforeseen historic damage to the building was uncovered; the stained glass windows were found to be no longer watertight, and the metal cramps, holding the historic Bath Stone in place, were found to be critically corroded, leading to an additional £200,000 of costs.

We still need to raise £135k to protect the future of the building. By raising funds with your community, you can help to secure Trinity's past, future and present.

You can make a huge difference by raising funds in your community to directly support our building works. By having fun and connecting with friends, colleagues and family through fundraising, you will help us to protect the future of Trinity, so that we can continue to provide opportunities for people like Davontay. We challenge you to raise £250 before our Garden Party on 13th May 2018, and then come along to the party and celebrate your achievements with us while we say a massive thank you.

Ways to fundraise

Whether you want to make a fundraising event as unique as your community is, or follow our suggestions below, fundraising can be for everyone and is a great way to spend time with people you love.

FUNdraising with friends

- Get creative in the kitchen and make a big meal for family and friends, asking for a donation to Trinity as their 'meal ticket'
- Get into the spirit of Ramadan and make your donations to Trinity
- Step into Spring by organising a sponsored walk, bike ride or run
- Make Spring cleaning fun by hosting a clothes swap, taking a stall at a bootfair or selling items online
- Ask for donations at your local community group/ church/ mosque/ temple/ club
- Got a secret talent? Show it off by organising a night in your neighbourhood, it could be a karaoke night, a comedy performance or a dance night
