## Jacob's Wells Baths

The Council's CAT Group met on 12 June and considered the future of the vacant JWB site.

We understand that neither Trinity Community Arts nor l felt able to collaborate and prepare a joint proposal for the future of the building. Following an approach by , sent us an alternative proposal. This is based on either buying the freehold, or on acquiring a long lease. s proposal is intended to prevent it being sold at auction to an anonymous bidder, and to secure it for artistic, leisure and community use.

Earlier this year, the Council deferred a decision on the disposal of the JWB building in order to create time to consider other options. The option of disposal will now be considered by Cabinet on 4 July. The Council would like to offer both Trinity and the opportunity to submit by 30 June any other proposal that could create greater social outcomes than a standard disposal at auction might achieve. This includes considering a direct sale at an undervalue (subject to a restrictive covenant on the freehold title), or a long lease without any residual risk or expense to the Council, or any similar mechanism that could achieve social outcomes and preserve this property as a community asset.

The Council is unable to continue to cover the ongoing cost of this vacant property, so any alternative proposals will need to bear the full cost immediately.
